They need to be pictures and video that are capable of generating human emotion about your village or communities situation. Too many pictures or video's are FAR better that too few, so please supplement your written application with these with that in mind.

HOWEVER, THESE PICTURES AND VIDEO'S MUST BE OF YOUR COMMUNITY, YOUR PEOPLE AND YOUR WATER CRISIS, NOT OF OTHERS THAT CAN BE COMMONLY FOUND ALL ACROSS THE INTERNET FROM STOCK IMAGES OR THE LIKE. ANY APPLICATION THAT CONTAINS PHOTO'S OR VIDEO FROM SOURCES OTHER THAN YOUR OWN COMMUNITY WILL BE IMMEDIATELY DISQUALIFIED. The causes and projects that GWR supports and will seek funding for will be genuine, truthful and honest, with ZERO tolerance for anything otherwise.

Please provide a description of each picture or video submitted to we can understand exactly what it is, including any names so we can help convey them along to our Board and donor base in the most personal way possible.

Here are some of the types of video's and pictures we are looking for. If you have others beyond these, please submit them also.

Pictures of people from your village or community gathering drinking water for their households.

- Pictures or videos of the drinking water that may clearly show the dirt, debris or contaminants the water contains, (i.e. a clear glass with less than clear and clean water).

- Pictures or videos of people in your community actually drinking their water, particularly younger kids or the elderly.
- Kids in your community playing in “ground water”, particularly if it appears to be dirty or contaminated.
- Signs in your community around wells or other water sources that indicate the water is contaminated.
- Pictures of your communities water sources, (wells), showing people actually gathering water for their households.
- Pictures or videos of people in your community carrying jerry cans of water back to their households.
- Pictures or videos of some of the most impoverished and poor people in your community, the homes they dwell in, etc. that accurately convey economic situation around them.
- Pictures or videos of religious services in your community that show people in their praise services.
- Pictures or videos of animals or livestock wading through groundwater.
- Pictures or videos inside and outside of hospital and healthcare facilities that actually show the conditions there as well as the sick in care there.
- Pictures or videos that clearly show how valuable water is to the local community.
- Pictures or videos of ANY big water treatment facility in the area, as well as the facilities name which supplies water only to those that can afford it.
- Pictures of any vendors selling water on the streets to locals who can afford it. Please get a picture of their prices if possible.
- Pictures or videos of any large corporate facilities in your community that show the discrepancy between the rich and the poor.

Finally, if you have any true personal local stories that convey what is really going on with the water crisis within the community and will help grab at a readers emotions, please submit them here. These stories should have real names of real people that are being negatively impacted in your water crisis.
